Our passion is growing families. We know you want the chance to become a parent, so we've created the Limited-Risk Program and the Foundation Program, two surrogacy programs with options to help fit your budget and allow you to pursue a brighter future.

In our years of providing services to hopeful parents, we've found that the most detrimental elements to the surrogacy journey can be:

- · Unnecessary long wait times.
- · Getting in line behind too many hopeful parents without enough surrogates.
- · Not enough marketing and outreach to find the best possible candidates.

Here are the three key ways we do it differently:

1 More Marketing and Outreach

More marketing, advertising and outreach = more opportunities and lower wait times. Our higher level of marketing also benefits you by:

- Reaching more potential surrogates, which we narrow down to find the best possible candidates.
- **Prescreening our surrogates** to ensure they are American Society of Reproductive Medicine (ASRM) qualified, meaning they are ready to move forward in the process even before matching.

Compare that to most other professionals that:

- · Offer less marketing and reach far fewer qualified surrogates.
- Don't prescreen as thoroughly, adding an unnecessary delay to your timeline while your surrogate undergoes additional screenings, which can take months.

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2 Maintaining a Balanced List of Clients

Our families don't want to wait 2.5 to 4 years to become parents. They want to connect with a highly qualified surrogate as quickly as possible. With both programs, our clients connect with a qualified surrogate in **1 – 6 months on average**. Here is how we do it:

- We only work with highly qualified surrogates. We also maintain a balanced list of clients to keep a 1:1 ratio.
- Maintaining a balanced list of clients means you aren't stuck waiting in line for a match because of too much competition for a small number of surrogates.

Compare that to many professionals that:

- Accept hundreds of families to their list but aren't working with enough qualified surrogates.
- Aren't concerned with keeping your wait times low and often can't give you an accurate estimate of how long your wait time will be.

We strive to provide you with support and comprehensive services from start to finish. You deserve a safe experience and complete financial transparency so that you can prepare for the emotional and financial investment on your journey to becoming a parent.
